We're open to the public every Friday beginning at 4pm. Last Fridays of the month are called Beer Fridays and offer more music and later hours.

Every Beer Friday we highlight a local non-profit through our Cheers! for Charity program. A portion of every beer sold goes straight to the preselected organization.



All other Fridays are called Beer Garden Fridays. BGFs are generally a little more chill than Beer Fridays offering acoustic music and a more relaxed vibe.

All ages are welcome on Fridays, have a valid ID and be 21+ to drink beer.

Pets are always welcome at the brewery, indoors and out.

DC packaged beer and growler fills are available to-go on Fridays. Can't make it on Friday and need some beer? Stop by during the week, M-T, 9:30am-5pm and we're happy to help. Please give us a heads-up call since we host private events during the week.

#BYOG: Bring Your Own Glass

Everyone is encouraged to bring their own glass for drinking or purchase a DC pint glass with your first beer, yours to keep and reuse. Using one glass per person instead of a new glass with each beer helps us save hundreds of gallons of water a week and contributes to Devil's Canyon's commitment to sustainability. We're happy to give your glass a quick rinse between beer styles. (Read more in the FAQ below.)

DCBC FAQ

Q: What's the deal with bringing my own glass?

A: Bring a glass from home (any glass) or buy a DCBC glass (\$4) with your first pint. We are a certified sustainable brewery- your glass is yours all night and forever which saves water and energy as you do not receive a new glass with each beer. The DCBC crew will happily rinse your glass between beer styles. If you come with a glass, you need not buy one. (Standard pour for most beer is 16oz.) This is a 10-year DCBC tradition. Glass logo styles and colors change, so feel free to start a collection. Many people bring all their DCBC glasses when they bring a group of friends to the brewery- it's fun!

Q: Are you open to the public any time besides Friday?

A: Fridays from 4-10p (and LAST Fridays of the month from 4-11p) are the only times we're open to the public for gathering/drinking/socializing. If you'd like to purchase growlers and packaged beer to-go (and have a taste or two), you're welcome to come in during business hours M-F, 9:30am-5pm. (It's helpful if you give us a call first, because we host private parties just about every day or evening.) Occasionally, we have special events open to the public on days besides Friday. These events are posted on the calendar and announced on Facebook. If you'd like to host your next event at the brewery, use the handy form on the DCBC website, or email events@devilscañon.com.

Q: Can I reserve a table or tables on Fridays?

A: We do not take reservations for tables or areas, but there are some exceptions. If you'd like to rent one of our spaces, like the enclosed patio, during a Friday evening for a large party (25+ people), arrangements can be made with our Events department by submitting info on **this page**. (We appreciate a heads-up for large parties even if you are not renting a private area.)

If you want to save a spot for your friends, we get that, but we're all about community here-- we hope that if you are saving a space for a larger group that won't arrive for another hour and a few people need a place to eat their tater tots, you'll communicate with them and share your tables. Hey, you might even make some new friends in the process! Please be civil, be social, and understand that beer should bring people together.

Q: How do I get one of those cool mugs with the handle?

A: DCBC Beer Club members have handled mugs. Memberships are \$200/year and include perks like your own private locker and VIP area, discounts on events, exclusive events, special-release pre-orders/discounts, private Taproom line (no waiting for craft beer!) and more! There are currently 180 members. When a spot opens, you will be notified. There is no cost to be on the waiting list. Email beerclub@devilscañon.com and include your contact info to be added.

Q: What's Cheers! for Charity?

A: C!4C is Devil's Canyon's donation program. Officially started in 2011, Cheers! for Charity gives back to local non-profits by giving a portion of every Beer Friday's beer sales directly to the organization. With your help, we donate over \$10K a year to local non-profits through the C!4C program, so drink up for a good cause every Beer Friday!

Q: WHAT?! I CAN REALLY BRING MY KIDS TO THE BREWERY?

A: Yes, we welcome families to the brewery, but please keep in mind that the overarching theme of Fridays is a relaxed atmosphere of fun born of mutual respect. In other words, if you're cool, we're cool. We expect kids to act appropriately while having a blast. Here are five basic, common-sense guidelines:

1. Kids should be near their guardians AT ALL TIMES. We get it, your kid is mature and knows where to find you. Friday events can become very crowded, though, so please make sure your kid isn't running around through the crowd, no one likes to spill beer. Think pool rules- no running! If your kid keeps it cool, we're cool.

2. Kids should never, ever, EVER enter restricted areas. Restricted areas are areas which are not easily accessible, blocked off, marked "employees only", behind closed doors (like the Green Room) and the main stage. DCBC is a full-scale production facility- there are many sharp/heavy/awkward/pointy/fragile/hot/slippery things in the restricted areas-- keep an eye out and do not let your children go into these areas. Guests assume responsibility and liability for incidents occurring in restricted areas if entered without the express consent and supervision of the Devil's Canyon Brew Crew.

3. No one, including kids, should cause damage to other people, other people's property, or DCBC property. You break it, you buy it. Just kidding (but not really). Please treat others and others' things with respect.

4. We expect that there will be at least one guardian in the children's party who is sober and responsible. Whether you're driving, ride-sharing or walking, please have at least one sober point-person who is ultimately in charge of corralling the kids in your party.

5. AGAIN- KEEP IT COOL. We allow kids because we want as many people to enjoy our wonderful community as possible-- that's part of what makes Fridays so fun! We really want to keep Fridays open to everyone, so please make sure your kids are well-behaved.

We really appreciate you and your families and welcome everyone. If the above guidelines are followed, it allows everyone to have a better time. Thank you for respecting the rules and one another.

Q: I can bring my pet, too?

A: Of course! Pets are allowed both inside and outside. If you need water for your pet, just ask a Brew Crew member. Fridays can become very crowded- we recommend you keep your pet on a leash.

Q: Do I need my ID to get in?

A: No, but you must be 21+ with valid ID to drink beer, no matter how old you are! Upon entry with ID, you'll receive a wristband which tells our staff you've been ID'd at the door.

Q: Can I bring my own booze to the brewery?

A: No, because our license does not allow other alcohol to be consumed onsite during public hours. We think our selection (usually about 10) of beer styles all made right here at the brewery will quench your thirst!

Q: Do you serve anything besides beer?

A: Yes. We make incredibly delicious craft Root Beer with no alcohol, caffeine, nor high fructose corn syrup. We also offer other soft drinks. If you have a food sensitivity which precludes you from drinking beer, we suggest stopping by and visiting our friends at Cuvée Cellars, Russian River, Flying Suitcase or Domenico tasting rooms (all located right around the corner from the brewery) for a glass or two. Remember, though, you cannot bring wine onto DCBC property (see above).
